### Regarding Reopening of Schools

Dear Parents

We would like to apprise you that as per the guidelines issued by MHRD and the latest by UP Govt., dated October 10, 2020, schools are allowed to reopen for classes IX to XII from October 19, 2020 subject to the following conditions:

1. Online classes shall continue after 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2020.
2. Students may attend the school only with the written consent of parents.
3. Attendance in the school must not be forced, and must depend entirely on parental consent.
4. In case some students prefer to attend online classes, they may be permitted to do so.
5. Schools planning to re-open, will have to mandatorily follow the Standard Operating Procedures issued by MHRD, CBSE and State Education department.

Keeping these directives in mind, we are planning to reopen the school for the classes mentioned above in a phased manner from 20<sup>th</sup> October, 2020.

1. **Phase I: From 20<sup>th</sup> October, 2020 till Diwali break-** Classes will be held in school for X and XII only on alternate days, i.e. Monday, Wednesday and Friday
2. **Phase II: After Diwali break** - classes will be held for IX to XII
3. In Phase I, the school would like to call students of X and XII for doubt-clearing sessions of 1 to 1.5 hours , followed by a 4-period time table per day . The doubt clearing sessions will be conducted in the school from 8: 00 am onwards. Students attending the school for doubt clearing sessions will be allowed to attend the regular classes of 3.5 hours every day in the school. Teachers teaching X and XII will be available in the school from 7:50 am to 2:10 p.m.

We request parents to volunteer to be part of the School reopening committee which is being set up to make suggestions, reviewing the SOPs (standard operating procedures) pertaining to health and safety and monitoring their implementation.

I request each parent to submit the questionnaire by clicking on the given link latest by October 16, 2020 and facilitate us to plan with precision, prudence and determination.
